Maturity Levels

- Explain the company performance by chapters and not individual questions.
 - Level 1: Commit to Responsible Care®.
 - Level 2: Initiate and Plan.
 - Level 3: Improve Continuously.
 - Level 4: Promote and Sustain Excellence.

- ❖ The simple multi-choice questions (101) are structured along the six elements of the Responsible Care® Global Charter.
